Tent sites are \$15.50/night Sunday through Thursday and \$17.50/night Friday, Saturday and holidays. Laundry facilities and showers available. Beach, picnic shelters and boat ramps. Restaurant and store. Open year round, but restaurant closed December through February. Winter rates available. 4 motel rooms available, call for prices. Pets allowed on leash. Prices do not include tax.

Located on Highway 27, 10 miles north of Pullman. 7 sites are available on a first-come first-serve basis. \$15.00 per night with 1 vehicle allowed. Sites are limited to two vehicles total, please add \$5.00 to camping fee for second vehicle. Electrical and water hookups are not available. Restrooms available year round. Each campsite has a picnic table and grill. Water is available in select locations of the campground from April 15th - October 15th. Camp sites are limited to vehicles 18' in length or smaller. Larger vehicles are not permitted on the campground road, however, the upper parking area may be utilized for overnight accommodations. Entrance is gated from dusk to 7:00am.

Located 20 miles north of Pullman. 60 sites with water & electric hook-up. \$20/night, unless during the fair. Prices during the fair are \$35.00/partial & \$60.00/full. Dump station service is available for your RV for an additional \$5.00 (\$7.00 if not camping). Open year-round but no water October 15 through April 15. No reservations required except during the fair in September.

### Rosalia RV Park

Located adjacent to the Rosalia City Park, 42 miles north of Pullman. Price: \$25.00 per night. Each site has 50 amp, 30 amp, or 20 amp available for use. Each site has its own water supply. 6 sites are available. RV dump 1 block away. Outdoor pool with water slide and low diving board open 1<sup>st</sup> weekend in June through weekend before Labor Day. Tennis and basketball courts adjacent. RV park is open year round. Pets allowed on leash.

### Wawawai County Park

Located on the Snake River 16 miles south of Pullman. 9 campsites are available to campers on a first come first serve basis for \$15.00 a night and an additional \$5.00 for a second vehicle (maximum of two vehicles per site). Water is available at the campground from mid-April through mid-October. The campground offers 5 pull in sites (2 with sand tent pads) and 4 pull through recreational vehicle sites. None of the sites have hookups. Tent camping is permitted at every site. Each campsite offers a picnic table and fire pit with a grill. Restroom facilities are available year round. Campfires are permitted from October 11<sup>th</sup> through June 9<sup>th</sup>. From June 10<sup>th</sup> through October 10<sup>th</sup> only barbecue briquettes and gas grill and lanterns are permitted, open fires are restricted because of a high fire danger. Entrance is gated from dusk to 7:00am.

Located 8 miles west of Clarkston on Highway 12, approximately 45 miles from Pullman. 4 cabins, 16 tent sites, 13 tent/RV sites, 32 sites have full hook-ups. Open May-October \$30.00/night for hook-up site \$24 for tent site, \$69 for cabin. Swimming area and 5 boat docks. Day use available for a fee.

### Palouse Falls State Park

Located 80 miles from Pullman. Take Highway 260 at Washtucna, then Highway 261 to the park. 10 tent spaces (1 ADA accessible) for \$12/night. \$10 fee for extra vehicle. 1 restroom - ADA accessible. No hook-ups. Maximum site length is 40 feet. All campsites are first-come, first-served. No reservations. Pets allowed on leash. Please note a Discover Pass is required for day use in all state parks. No pass required for overnight camping.
