

18 Hole Disc Golf Course

Disc golf is at Sunnyside Park because we have shown that this sport can co-exist with other activities. Help guarantee disc golf's continued presence at the park.

- Exercise the utmost caution when throwing a disc near people or property.
- Keep the course clean Dispose of ALL your trash properly.

1	3	292'	+3'	Υ	
2	3	343'	+2'	N	
3	3	333'	-21'	N	Hilltop at dogleg hides target from tee.
4	3	167'	+9'	N	Pathway near target is hidden from tee. Post a lookout for people if you can.
5	3	329'	+35'	Y	Throw hard. #5's elevation rise makes it more like 400' or more.
6	3	170'	-13'	Y	A breeze on #6 can blow your birdie drive to double-bogieville.
7	3	205'	-20'	Y	Target barely visible. Overshoot #7 and watch it roll into the woods.
8	3	307'	+17'	Y	
9	3	257'	-26'	N	Target #3 visible from tee #9 . Step forward around tree to sight target #9.
10	3	264'	+6'	Υ	Picnickers often around #10. Lost disc? Overshoots can roll into pond.
11	3	202'	+26'	Υ	
12	3	165'	-33'	Υ	Target #12 barely visible. Discs often roll quite a distance past target.
13	3	225'	+9'	Υ	
14	3	336'	+11'	Υ	A disc thrown into the summer thicket is a stickery situation. Try to avoid it.
15	3	198'	-14'	Υ	
16	3	340'	+54'	Υ	Throw hard. #16's elevation rise makes it more like 450' or more.
17	3	207'	-30'	Y	
18	3	323'	-8'	Υ	Be aware of people and cars in parking lot behind target when you throw.

Front 9	27	2272'
Back 9	27	2381'
Course	54	4653'

General Notes and Cautions:

Foot traffic on park pathways can often be hidden from view. Make sure pathways are clear before you throw.

Tees are marked with wood timbers, flush to the ground and perpendicular to fairway. Timbers demark the holeward limit of the tee area. Hole number and distance appear on each timber.

Be considerate when retrieving an errant disc from agricultural crops or public gardens. Do no damage.

A walking tour of the entire course (Tee 1 to Target 18) is about 1.3 miles.
