Established Investment Levels

Financial Institutions

Banks and Savings and Loans will pay a base fee of \$580 plus \$25 for each million dollar of deposits in the Pullman branch.

Non-profit Organizations

\$150—Non-profit organizations such as churches, support groups and community clubs can join the chamber to help build the community they serve.

Individuals

\$60—Individuals can become involved with their community through participation in community activities, committees, and special events. Individual memberships do not include use of promotional opportunities.

Students

\$30 or 8 volunteer hours—This is a great way for WSU and Pullman High School students to gain business experience and become involved in the community.
